REQUIREMENTS FOR INSTITUTE TEAMS

Only schools, not individuals, may enroll in the Math Olympiads. However, if a group of students attend an Institute that meets regularly outside of school hours, then the Institute may enroll teams providing it identifies itself to us as an Institute Team and it agrees to observe the following three special rules, which are in addition to our general rules.

1. **If a student's school participates in the Math Olympiads, the student may not be a member of the Institute team, whether or not the student is on the school team.** It is the responsibility of the supervisor of the Institute Team to actively ensure that all team members comply with this condition.
2. **The Institute team may not give an Olympiad contest any sooner than the Saturday following our scheduled date for that contest.** The student's school must have a reasonable chance to give the contest first.
3. Students are eligible for all Individual Awards. However, **Institute Teams are NOT eligible for any Team Awards**, since the teams have the capability of an unfair advantage over single school-based teams.

Please note that no student may be given the contest online. All students must take the contest using paper and pencil at the same time and at the same location.

We would consider the "team" provided the "Supplemental Application for Institute or Home School Association Teams" is filled out completely.
